

What is DebiCheck?

DebiCheck allows control over your bank account debit orders, providing you with a one-time electronic confirmation from your bank within 48 hours. DebiCheck is a safe procedure that details the exact amount and the date that we will debit your bank account as payment for your insurance policy with us. The authentication process will be required following a conversation with us or when a change is made to your policy.

View your bank's step-by-step process below:

Select 'Other Transactions' on the screen display until you can see the 'DebiCheck Debit Orders' option. Select the DebiCheck mandate you want to action from the pending list. View the details on the debit order mandate and approve.

Yes, DebiCheck is a very secure solution using authentication and encryption to ensure approved payments and account security.




Can I use DebiCheck to manage debit orders from any bank account?
